EXHIBIT A

Governing Board "FOR" Argument

The Glendale Elementary School District (GESD) currently operates with a 15% Maintenance and Operation (M&O) override approved by voters in 2013 and again in 2018. Your "yes" vote to renew the override is critical if we are to continue to provide opportunities to better prepare our students for today's competing global environment.

If the M&O override is not approved, the District will be required to reduce its funding by 1/3 (or over \$3 million) in 2025 and by 2/3 (or over \$6 million) in 2026.
