

Superintendent Watson Appoints Tee Lambert to Washington Elementary School District Governing Board

(Phoenix, AZ) –Maricopa County School Superintendent Steve Watson has appointed Tee Lambert to the Washington Elementary School District Governing Board in central Phoenix.

Watson's appointment fills a vacancy that occurred after the resignation of Larry Herrera, who was elected in 2018. Lambert will serve the remainder of his four-year term, which expires with the November 2022 election. Forty-five district residents applied for the position and Watson interviewed 20.

"Mrs. Lambert has proven herself to be a dedicated public school advocate and has a long list of accomplishments in education leadership and administration. She's been a member of her district's governing board before and is a parent of four children who attended her district's schools," said Watson.

"My goal is to listen to administration recommendations, and to district parents and community member suggestions and concerns and take those into consideration in the Board's decisionmaking, all with a focus on improving student achievement and closing the learning gaps," Lambert said.
