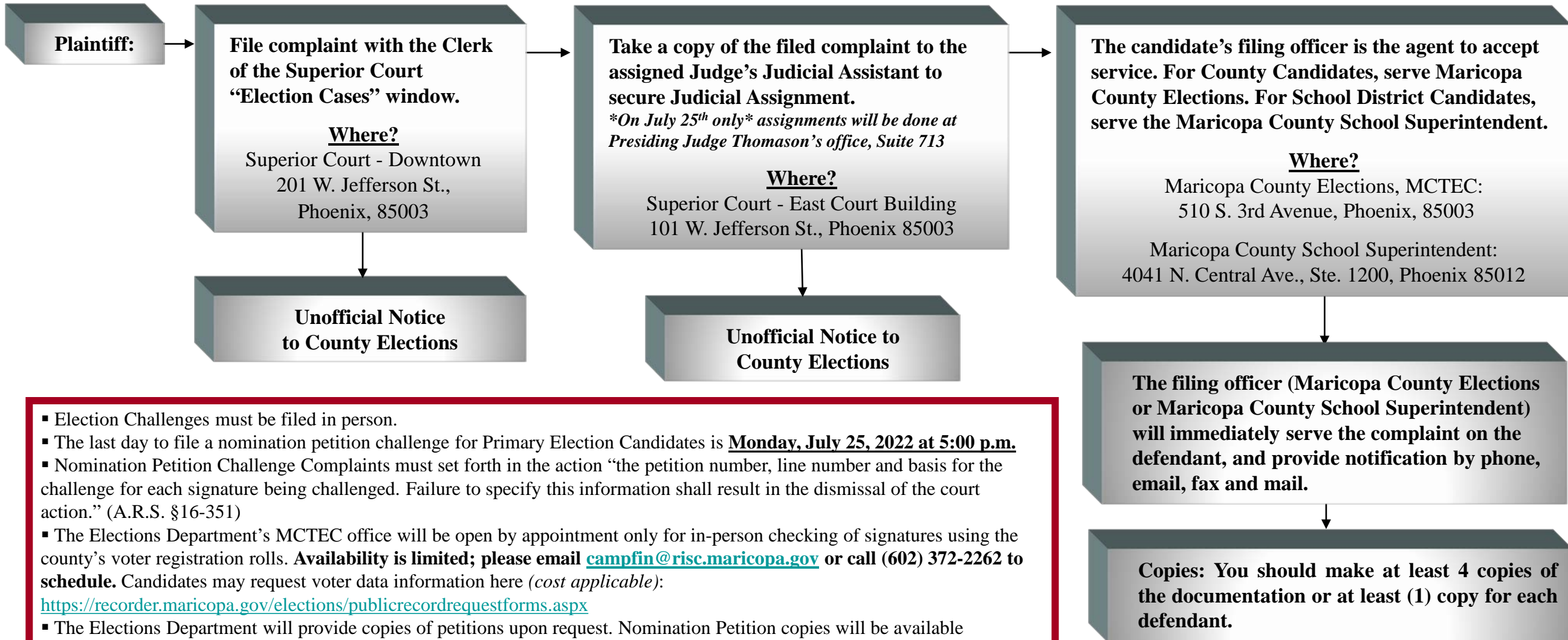




CANDIDATE CHALLENGE PROCESS & PROCEDURES



- Election Challenges must be filed in person.
- The last day to file a nomination petition challenge for Primary Election Candidates is **Monday, July 25, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.**
- Nomination Petition Challenge Complaints must set forth in the action “the petition number, line number and basis for the challenge for each signature being challenged. Failure to specify this information shall result in the dismissal of the court action.” (A.R.S. §16-351)
- The Elections Department’s MCTEC office will be open by appointment only for in-person checking of signatures using the county’s voter registration rolls. **Availability is limited; please email campfin@risc.maricopa.gov or call (602) 372-2262 to schedule.** Candidates may request voter data information here (*cost applicable*): <https://recorder.maricopa.gov/elections/publicrecordrequestforms.aspx>
- The Elections Department will provide copies of petitions upon request. Nomination Petition copies will be available beginning Tuesday, July 12, 2022 at 9 a.m. *If a candidate files prior to the filing deadline, copies are available upon request. A reasonable turnaround timeframe is necessary to provide those copies.*
- Paper copies are \$0.25 per page. There is no copy fee if provided electronically. However, there is a \$3.00 charge for certified copies, whether provided by paper or electronic copy.
